KINCHELOE, MI — Businesses can learn about Responding to Federal Government Solicitations at a class December 9 in Kincheloe. The class will run from 1:00 p.m. to 3:30 p.m. at the Chippewa County EDC, 5019 W. Airport Drive. The class is part of the “Doing Business with the Government Series,” and is being offered by the Northwest Michigan Procurement Technical Assistance Center (PTAC) in partnership with Eastern U.P. Michigan Works! and the Chippewa County Economic Development Corporation.

In the class businesses will look at what factors they should consider before bidding, how the government evaluates offers, tips for responding to a request for proposal (RFP), and more.
