Call to Order

Incumbent Worker Plan

Janie McNabb, Director of Program Development, presented the Incumbent Worker Plan. She discussed the current issues and difficulties resulting from the USDOL's new restrictions on use of Incumbent Worker funds, and asked for board input and ideas. Discussion ensued, and a decision was reached to submit the plan as in previous years to give staff more time to research possible alternative program approaches.

Employment Services Plan

Janie presented the Employment Services Plan. With the exception of a funding reduction, the plan remains the same as in previous years.

Workforce Investment Act 5-Year Plan

Janie presented the WIA 5-Year Plan and answered questions.

Motion by D. Pratt, supported by G. Kaminski, to approve the Workforce Investment Act 5-Year Plan. Motion carried.

Appointment of EAG Chairperson – Dr. Jason Jeffrey, TBAISD

Elaine reported that at the last meeting, the board appointed the new membership of its Education Advisory Group (EAG), which also serves as the region's Youth Council and Adult Learning Partnership Board. However, we forgot to appoint the Chairperson of the EAG. Staff recommended Dr. Jason Jeffrey of TBAISD, who has taken an active role in leading the EAG for several years.

Motion by C. Dillon, supported by D. Parkes, to approve the Appointment of EAG Chairperson – Dr. Jason Jeffrey, TBAISD. Motion carried

UpSkills Program

Jan Warren, Michigan Works! Program Director, gave a report on the UpSkills Program that was conducted for the past year under Recovery Act funds. The program was very successful and portions of it will be incorporated into regular adult education programming. Discussion ensued and questions were answered.

Adult Learning Partnership

Elaine and Christy Nelson, Adult Education Coordinator, gave a report on the Adult Learning Partnership's activities over the past year and plans for the coming year. The Adult Ed Program was recently awarded a second grant from the Department of Labor & Economic Growth to scale up its efforts to transition adult ed students into post-secondary training.

Michigan Green Jobs Report: A Regional Analysis

Elaine pointed out the report that was included in the board packet and encouraged board members to read it, as it provides a good description of "green" jobs and how our region fares in this area.

YouthBuild & SBTDC partnership

Janie made a presentation on how two programs of NWMCOG – YouthBuild and the SBTDC – have teamed up to offer entrepreneurial training to young adults. Videos and more information are available on the web site at nwm.org.
