## Why Export to China?

- China is the United States' third largest trading partner after Canada and Mexico. U.S. goods exports to China increased nearly \$3 billion in 2014, totaling about \$124 billion.
- Small and medium-sized enterprises (SMEs) are the leading exporters to China, representing over 90% of U.S. businesses exporting to China and about 35% of total exports by value.
- China's rapid economic growth, especially in the urban areas, has led to a booming consumer market for high-end goods and services, including tourism and education. China will consume \$27 billion worth of luxury goods by 2015, 20% of the world market.
- China's market is geographically diverse with each region full of unique opportunities.
