#### **Call to Order and introductions**

The bid process was reviewed and she reported that it would commence in January. Ultimately it will come before the board for action.

#### **Review Talent Strategic Agenda**

E. Wood reviewed the Talent Strategic Agenda for 2013-2020 and gave an update on the various activities that are taking place surrounding each Goal and Strategy. Many of the activities are being undertaken by the Talent District Career Council (TDCC), and she wanted board members to see how closely this work is aligned with the board's overall strategic plan.

#### **Review work of Talent District Career Council - TDCC**

T. Vandercook, J. Rummer and D. Cox provided an informal review of the many activities being undertaken by the Michigan Works-Education partnership with the TDCC at the lead. The TDCC is a committee of the Networks Northwest Board. All its activities revolve around talent pipeline development, STEM exposure, career awareness and exposure, Career-Tech education, employability skills, and adult education. They gave many examples and discussion ensued.

#### Report on Jobs for Michigan's Graduates - JMG

T. Vandercook gave a report on the JMG program and our unique operational partnership with the three Intermediate School Districts for its delivery. The content of the program was reviewed, along with numbers served and overall goals. J. Rummer and D. Cox spoke highly of both the JMG program and the partnership with Michigan Works. Questions were answered.
