#### Call to Order

Chair Friend called the meeting to order at 3:03 pm on Wednesday, April 23rd, 2025.

### 1. Roll Call of Voting Members

#### 2. Approval of Agenda and Meeting Minutes

The agenda was reviewed and approved with minor corrections to member names and other details.

**Motion:** Lemcool moved, supported by Marek, to approve the March 26, 2025 Policy Board meeting minutes.

Result: Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote

**3.** Public comment was opened, but no comments were received, so the meeting moved forward.

#### 4. Presentation: Long-Range Planning – Travel Demand Modeling

The Video Presentation from Daniela was played - Daniela (MDOT) provided an overview of the TTCI Travel Demand Forecast Model (TDFM), emphasizing its role in estimating future travel patterns based on household characteristics. The model evaluates federally aided road systems using a base year of 2022 and projects to the horizon year 2050.

Application of the TDFM in long-range transportation planning Integration with the Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP) Future steps involving documentation, MTP chapter development, and congestion analysis

Barry Hicks noted that the model and its findings will directly contribute to the MTP update.

#### 5. New Business – BATA Transit Project Forms & Change Requests

Isha Pithwa (Networks Northwest) presented revisions to several BATA transit project forms.

- Handley (BATA) confirmed there were currently no cost changes
  - O Any adjustments exceeding a 20% cost change will require reapproval
  - O Job number 224053 may undergo updates and will be monitored
  - These are based on estimates BATA receive more allocation when MDO sends them. Not expecting numbers until 2<sup>nd</sup> week of May.
- Mayle (MDOT) emphasized that significant changes in scope, work type, funding changes, etc. require formal committee amendments. There is a list of changes that affect fed-amendment. Any changes that affect federal amendment has to be approved by the committee. Under 25% is admin modification.
- Hicks recommended approving all proposed updates to avoid delays

**Motion:** Sanders moved, supported by Mullane, to approve the BATA forms as presented and to allow for cost changes up to 25% without requiring a separate reapproval.

**Result:** Motion passed unanimously on a voice vote.

#### 6. Continuing Business

#### A. Draft FY 26 UWP Review

Barry Hicks presented the draft FY26 UWP, highlighting:

- Updated maps and demographic analysis
- Shifts in budget allocations, particularly a significant increase in long-term planning efforts
- Clarifications:
  - Page 30 requires updated mapping (referenced in the TIP document)

- Page 37 contains the overall planning budget, showing a 2% increase in total expenditures
- Yellow highlights denote sections with modified funding or narrative edits
- Removed text reflects the completed establishment of the MPO; new content focuses on future planning goals and activities

Approval is expected at the May meeting.

#### B. Draft FY 26-29 TIP Review

- ■Demographic analysis adjustments (previously labeled "Environmental Justice") to better reflect vulnerable populations' needs
- ■Hicks confirmed that approval of the TIP can occur at the May or June meeting
- ■LCRC's Cherry Bend Road project will remain in the 2026 program year
- ■BATA projects scheduled for 2029 are structurally consistent with earlier years
- ■Ongoing work to finalize funding tables (page 107), which include capital needs and operational maintenance
- ■MDOT's public comment period (open through May 17) will be considered for the MTP
- ■Question/Suggestion made to include the Active transportation plan projects to be included in TIP or as an appendix to the TIP.
- Clarification from Mayle: TIP inclusion requires confirmed funding
- 7. Public comment was opened, but no comments were received, so the meeting moved forward.
- 8. Update or discussion on future agenda items:

Chair Friend suggested a future presentation by the Road Commission on east-west corridor studies and goal alignment.

SUBJECT: Items 5a-c: Consideration of FY 26 UWP and FY 26-29 TIP; Update regarding 2025 MTP

#### <u>Planning Documents and Processes</u>

TTCI is developing its first set of plans to guide transportation projects in the years ahead. This is an ongoing process, with each document moving through review and adoption by the TTCI Policy Board before being submitted to the Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) and the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT) for final approval.

- The **Unified Work Program (UWP)** outlines the transportation planning tasks and activities that TTCI will undertake over the next year to support regional mobility and infrastructure planning (*Reviewed and revised every year*)
- The **Transportation Improvement Program (TIP)**, which outlines planned transportation projects for the next three to four years (*Reviewed and revised every three years*)
- The **Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)**, a long-term vision for the region's transportation system (*Reviewed and revised every five years; looks at 20+ year horizon*)
