LAND PRESERVATION STATISTICS

(as of January 2008)



The current applications for PDR cover approx. 1,220 acres.

The Peninsula Township Agricultural Preservation Zone covers 9,500 acres.

The GT Regional Land Conservancy has protected approx. 1,332 acres in Peninsula Township in the form of Conservation Easements and Nature Preserves.

The State of Michigan and American Farmland Trust have protected approx 1,000 acres.

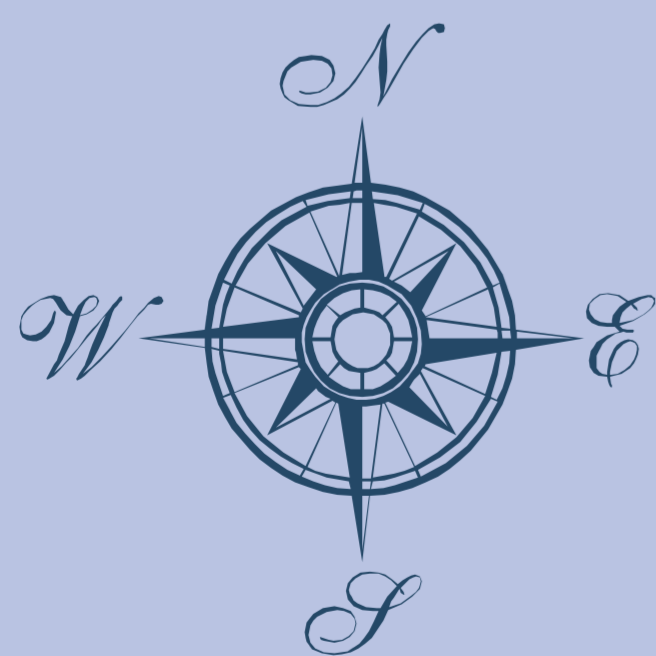
Peninsula Township's PDR Program has protected approx. 3,027 acres (includes ag. easements and SUP).
