Michigan Works in Petoskey Moves to New Location and Expands Service Hours

PETOSKEY, MI –The Northwest Michigan Works! Center in Petoskey will have a new location beginning August 31. The Center's new location will be 2240 Mitchell Park Drive, which is one street south of the previous site. The Center's Resource Room will also expand its hours of operation from three to four days per week. The Resource Room will now be open Monday through Thursday from 8:00 a.m. to noon, and 1:00 p.m. to 5:00 p.m.

The café will offer a menu of job search services for all levels of job seekers, including help with job search, résumés, interviewing, networking, and more.
