## Community Meeting Focuses on Health, Safety, and Welfare Issues

TRAVERSE CITY, MI – A community meeting in Traverse City will focus on how local policy impacts health, safety, and welfare issues. Those issues include addiction, child welfare, disease prevention, and basic needs such as food and housing. The meeting will be held Friday, January 20 from 7:45 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. in the Conference Room at the Traverse City Northwest Michigan Works! Center, 1209 South Garfield. The meeting is being hosted by Networks Northwest and Addiction Treatment Services.

Local leaders, human service providers, and other community stakeholders are encouraged to attend the meeting which is part of a Community Think Tank Discussion Series. The meeting will include a keynote presentation by James Haveman, the former Director of the Michigan Department of Mental Health. Other items on the agenda will include an update on the region's opioid epidemic, and discussion about how to better connect community policies and needs.

The outcomes of this meeting are intended to guide the development of a Health, Safety and Welfare chapter for the *Framework For Our Future*, a regional resource for communities working to meet local goals.
