An **incountry credit report** will provide the most recent obtainable information available on the company you are verifying to do business with outside the U.S. VAGTC's partner in-country financial firm will review all the information they are able to find on the party through government registrars, online resources and local resources. In some cases, this resource offers an in-person visit to the company location to interview the entity and/or contact via phone or email if an in-person visit is not possible. **Get the most up-to-date intelligence before working with a new customer or partner outside the U.S.** and take advantage of the MEDC funded in-country credit report.
