The Position

Having an emphasis on transportation and infrastructure programs, this position will also incorporate other aspects of regional planning program work. This Traverse City based position will have you working in one of the most desirable regions of Michigan.

Program work for this position includes, but is not limited to:

- Assisting the department in transportation program development and acting as a liaison with the Michigan Department of Transportation (MDOT), local units of government, and transportation agencies;
- Implementing the department's transportation programs including Asset Management, Rural Task Force, Small Urban Task Force, Pure Michigan Byways;
- Full lifecycle management of community development and regional planning projects;
- Assist with development of grant applications and reporting for grants obtained through the Community Development Department.

Requirements include, at a minimum, a Bachelor's degree in urban/regional planning, transportation planning, economics, civil engineering, public administration or a related field. A valid Michigan driver's license and the ability to be insured to drive agency vehicles is required. AICP certification and GIS experience/proficiency preferred.

Compensation

This is a full-time salaried position paying \$51,500 - \$53,000 per year, with benefits.
