Kelly Dunham asked about a template for local RTF bylaws. Josh Grab will follow up on this.

David McGough, Fife Lake Village President, mentioned that State Street and Boyd Street were heavily used and took a beating during roundabout construction. He was requesting crack sealing on the village roads, possibly through RTF. Wayne Schoonover recommended not going through the state's RTF process for a small scale project. He informed David McGough to check in to County crack sealing, and negotiate a deal or potentially use the County's rates.

Wayne Schoonover mentioned that he is a member of the RTF Oversight Advisory Board. He said if there were any concerns with the program to let him know. He acknowledged good changes over the past few years and a well-run program compared to other states.

The next meeting will be in early May and will be held at the BATA offices. A poll will be sent out at a later time to confirm a date for this meeting.
