Attached you will find three surveys – a Materials Management Planning Resident Survey, a MMP Local Units of Government Survey, and a MMP Local Business Survey. As previously mentioned, these surveys will be all inclusive to the region but we will be able to separate out the responses by County, and down to the municipality within the County for the resident survey if desired. Also, note the display logic for questions that will trigger based on responses.

#### **MMP Resident Survey**

The resident survey is primarily a 24 question multiple choice survey examining existing household practices, barriers, future considerations, and ways to increase interest, which should take about 8 minutes to complete. For the resident survey, we will be able to offer 5 \$50 gift cards to those who complete the survey – presumably one "winner" from each of the Counties we are involved in the MMP process with.

#### **MMP Local Units of Government Survey**

The local units of government survey is a 14 question survey that seeks to establish existing services, funding, MMP vision, effectiveness of material management in Counties, and challenges.
