# Part 115 Solid Waste Management

- Part 115, Solid Waste Management, of the Natural Resources and Environmental Protection Act, 1994 PA 451, as amended
   Specifically subpart 11 Materials Management Plans
- Plan updates to focus on sustainable materials management approaches, instead of disposal
- Allows for the County to have authority in its materials management
- Funding for the planning and implementation of the MMP is funded through the Renew Michigan Fund
- Development guided by respective Materials Management Planning Committees

#### SUSTAINABLE MATERIALS MANAGEMENT

PREFERRED Lower the amount and toxicity of REDUCE unwanted materials produced Use materials again and again REUSE instead of buying new Upcycle items no longer needed REPURPOSE for their original purpose Use unwanted materials to RECYCLE make new products Use discorded materials RECOVER to create energy LANDFILL Last resort


# MMP Requirements

- Guidance for County Materials: MMP is a program to guide the management of materials within counties.
  - **Focus on Sustainability:** It emphasizes sustainable practices like recycling and composting.
- **Safe Disposal:** It ensures safe disposal options for various materials like food waste, yard clippings, recyclables, and solid waste.
- Implementation Strategy: Develops strategies to meet those statewide goals.
- Facility Assessment: Identifies existing and needed materials management facilities.
  - **Capacity Planning:** Determines the required capacity for managing generated materials.
  - **Siting Process:** Outlines siting process for developing new facilities.

### MMP Goals

- Protect Health and Environment: Prevent adverse effects on public health, safety, and welfare, as well as natural resources, including protecting water, air, and land from improper materials management.
- Promote Sustainability: Ensure all managed materials are handled sustainably to achieve economic, community, and environmental benefits.
- Ensure Compliance: Guarantee all managed material is collected and processed or disposed at facilities that comply with all state statutes and rules or are managed appropriately out-of-state.








