Operated in partnership with the Economic Growth Institute at the University of Michigan, the Michigan Defense Center, an operation of the Michigan Economic Development Corporation, is offering small and medium - sized defense contractors a comprehensive one-stop shop to Department of Defense (DoD) cybersecurity compliance to help secure the defense industrial base—and your business.

This two-phase program has pre-qualified Michigan contractors to provide cybersecurity technical services to assist with the implementation of NIST SP 800-171 required for meeting the DFARS 252.204-7012 regulation required in all United States DoD and Homeland Security (DHS) contracts.

## Phase 1

Michigan small and medium - sized businesses can contract with the pre-approved vendor list to develop a gap analysis report at a pre-negotiated discounted cost of \$1,500 as the first step towards cybersecurity compliance.

## Phase 2

After completing Phase 1 businesses may qualify for up to \$22,500 in grant funding to address any deficiencies identified and to assist them in becoming fully compliant.
