MEDC's International Trade team is wrapping up recruitment on just a few more trade missions for 2024: UK and Netherlands in April, Australia and New Zealand in May with our partners at Automation Alley, and Brazil and Chile. MDARD 'Ag Exporter of the Year' Application Period Now Open

The Michigan Department of Agriculture and Rural Development (MDARD) is now accepting applications for the 2024 Michigan 'Ag Exporter of the Year'. MDARD annually recognizes a food, agriculture, or forestry exporting business that demonstrates success in export growth.

Eligibility is limited to Michigan agriculture, food and forest products producers, manufacturers, or shippers that are actively pursuing international markets. Products must be over 50% grown, processed, or manufactured in Michigan.

Companies of all sizes are encouraged to apply. **Applications are due by 5 p.m.** on Friday, March 29, 2024.

Build Global Partnerships with the Young Leaders of the Americas Initiative

As part of the U.S. Department of State's Young Leaders of the Americas Initiative (YLAI), 280 young business owners from across Latin America, the Caribbean and Canada travel to the United States for a four-week professional placement with a U.S. business/organization. The Fellows and their hosts collaborate on a codesigned project and together develop tools and skills that promote an economically prosperous hemisphere and bolster people-to-people ties. Over half of the participating U.S. companies have been small businesses. After the in-person component ends, the U.S. host can apply for a reciprocal grant to travel to the Fellow's home community and continue the collaboration. Additionally, the U.S. business owner becomes part of the YLAI Alumni Network, giving them access to events and an impressive and connected cadre of entrepreneurs across the hemisphere.

The 2024 YLAI program is seeking additional opportunities for placements in Detroit. Recruitment Ongoing: 2024 Trade Missions

May 2-15: <u>Automation Alley's trade mission to Australia and New Zealand</u>

Hosted by Automation Alley, up to ten companies are invited to engage in B2B meetings with potential buyers on this trade mission to Australia and New Zealand. The Australia-U.S. Free Trade Agreement allows 99% of U.S. exports to enter duty-free, and a shared common culture, business practices, and legal framework reduces non-tariff barriers to export to these markets.

May 11-18: Trade Mission to the United Kingdom and Netherlands

Join the MEDC for a trade mission to London, United Kingdom and Amsterdam, Netherlands. Participants will receive customized schedules of B2B meetings with prospective buyers, partners, and distributors. The mission also includes a cultural excursion, welcome reception, and negotiated group hotel rates.

June 8-14: GSGP's Trade Mission to Brazil and Chile

Join the MEDC and the Great Lakes and St. Lawrence Governors & Premiers for a multi-sector trade mission to São Paulo, Brazil and Santiago, Chile. These countries are strong U.S. trading partners and Brazil is home to South America's largest consumer market and GDP. Because these markets have complex regulatory and tax frameworks, leverage this opportunity to enter the market with assistance from Michigan's knowledgeable in-country trade experts.
